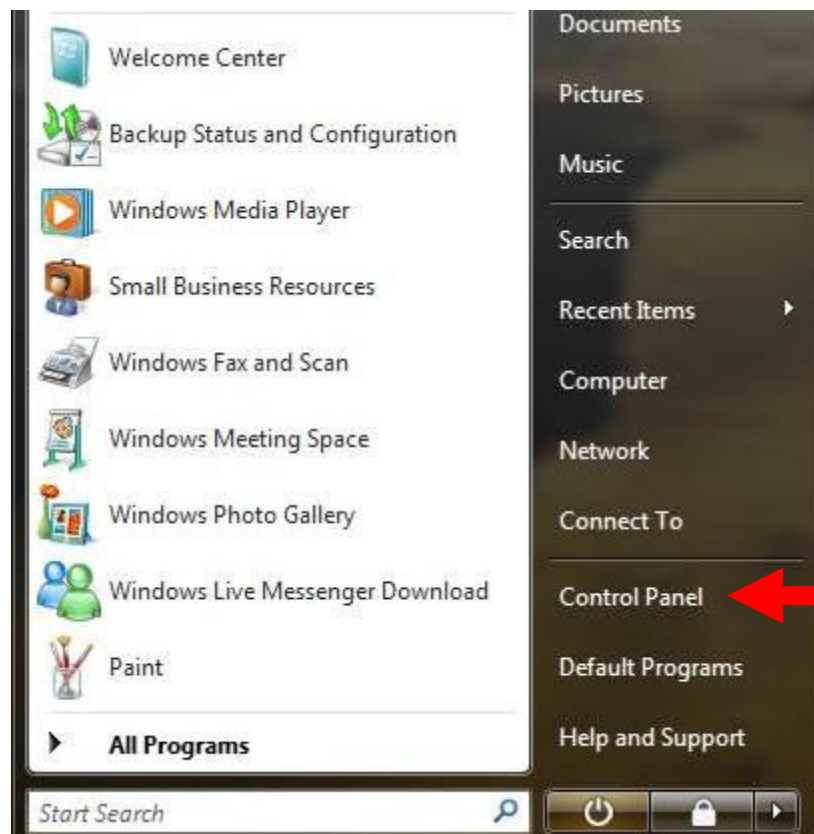


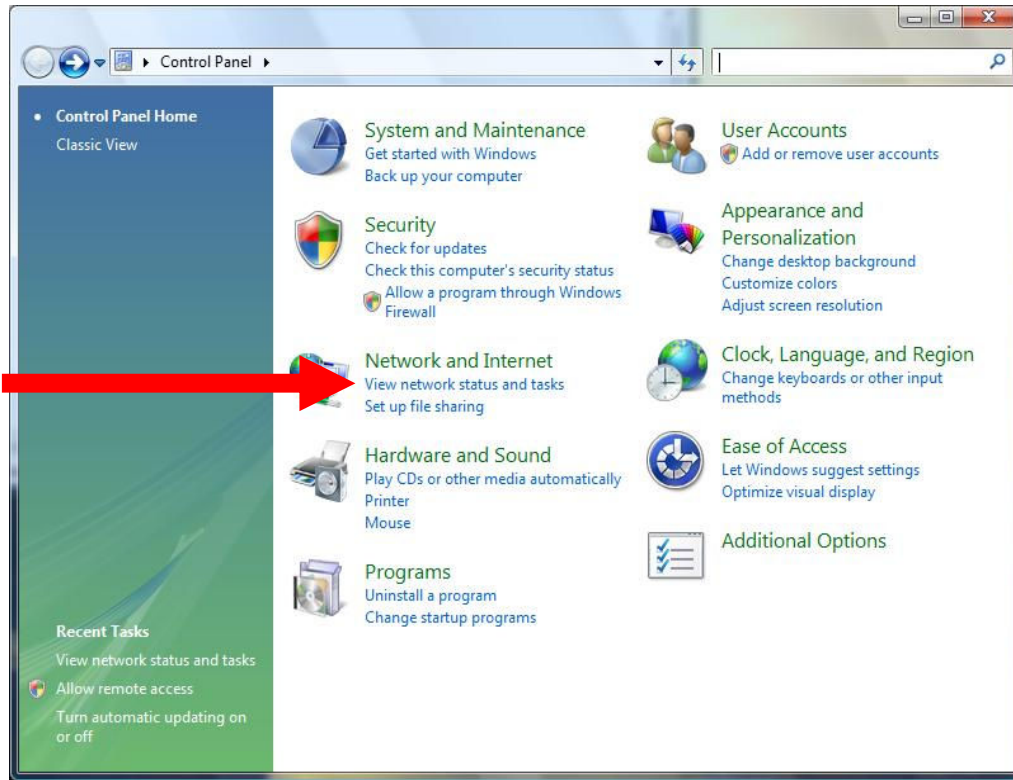
Configuring a Windows Vista computer for DHCP

In order to complete the following changes you must have Administrator rights on the computer that you are using.

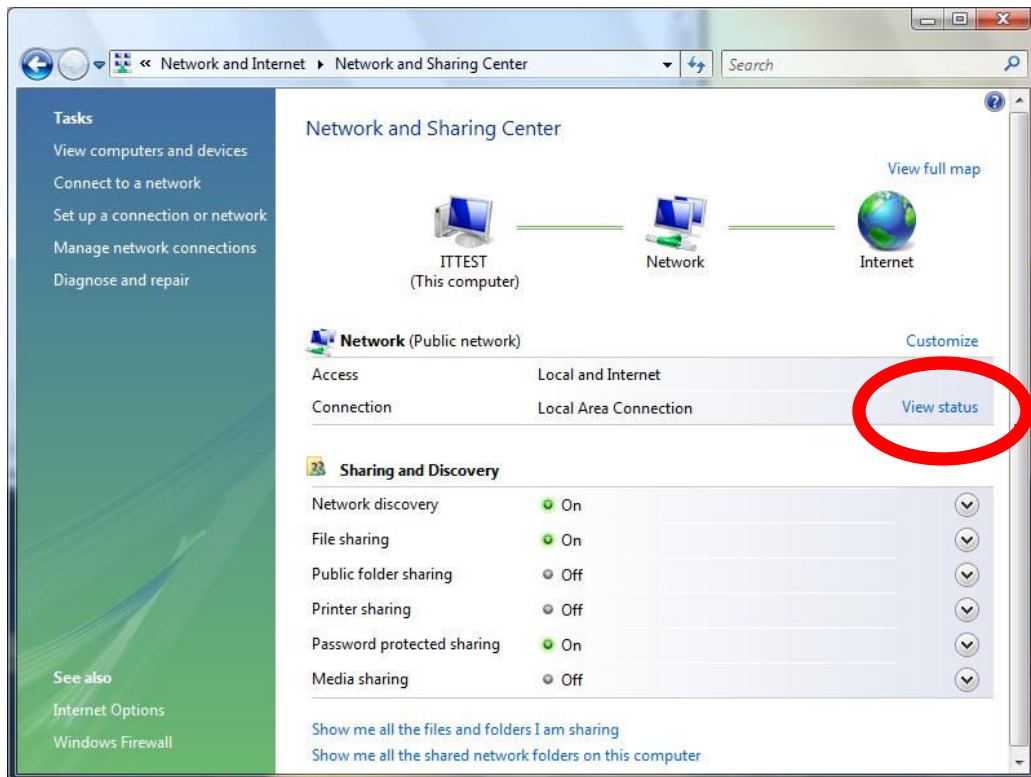
1. Click on the “Start” button and select “Control Panel”.



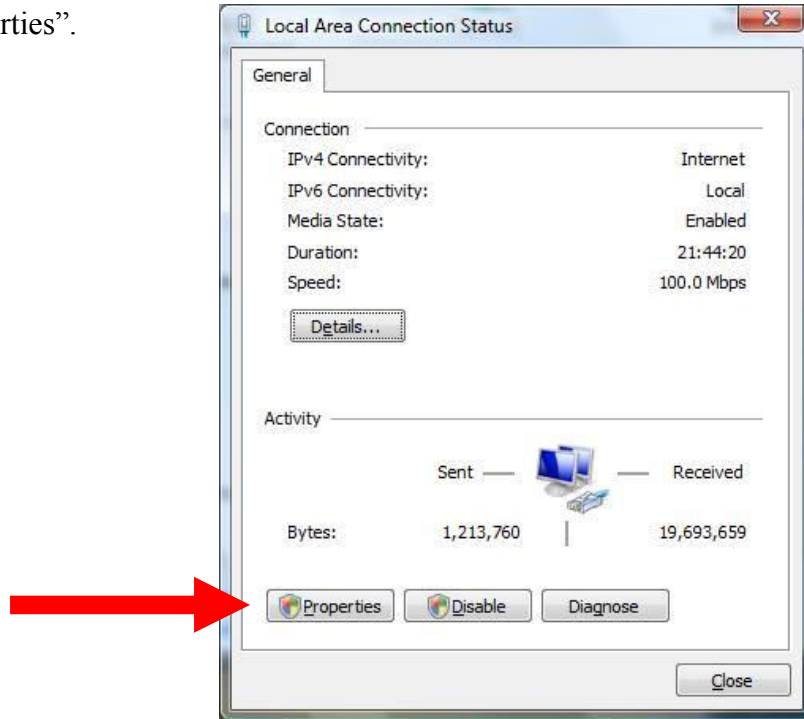
2. Click on “View network status and tasks” below the “Network and Internet” heading.



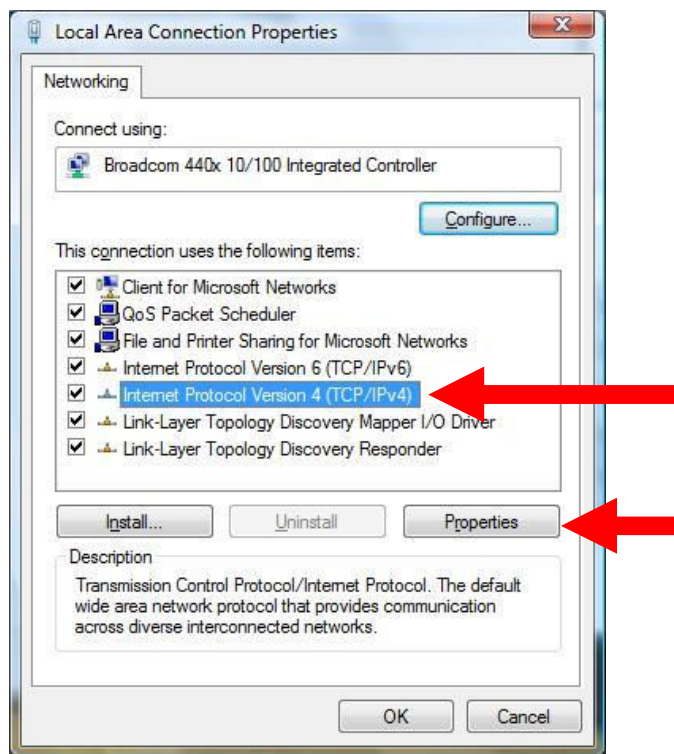
3. Click on the “View Status” link next to you network Connection.



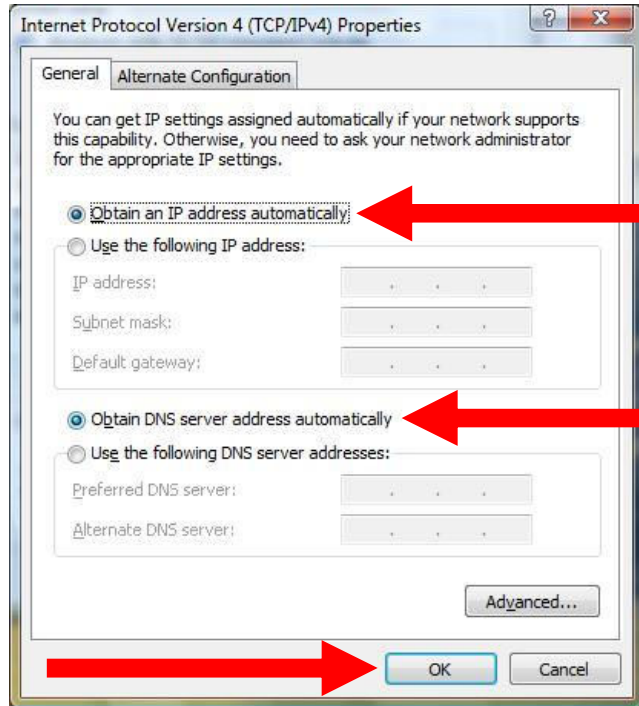
4. Click on “Properties”.



5. Select “Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)” and click on “Properties”.



6. On the “Internet Protocol Version 4(TCP/IPv4) Properties” window select the options “Obtain an IP address automatically” and “Obtain DNS server address automatically” and click “OK”.



7. Click “Close” on the “Local Area Connection Properties” window and “Local Area Connection Status” window to complete the DHCP configuration process.
