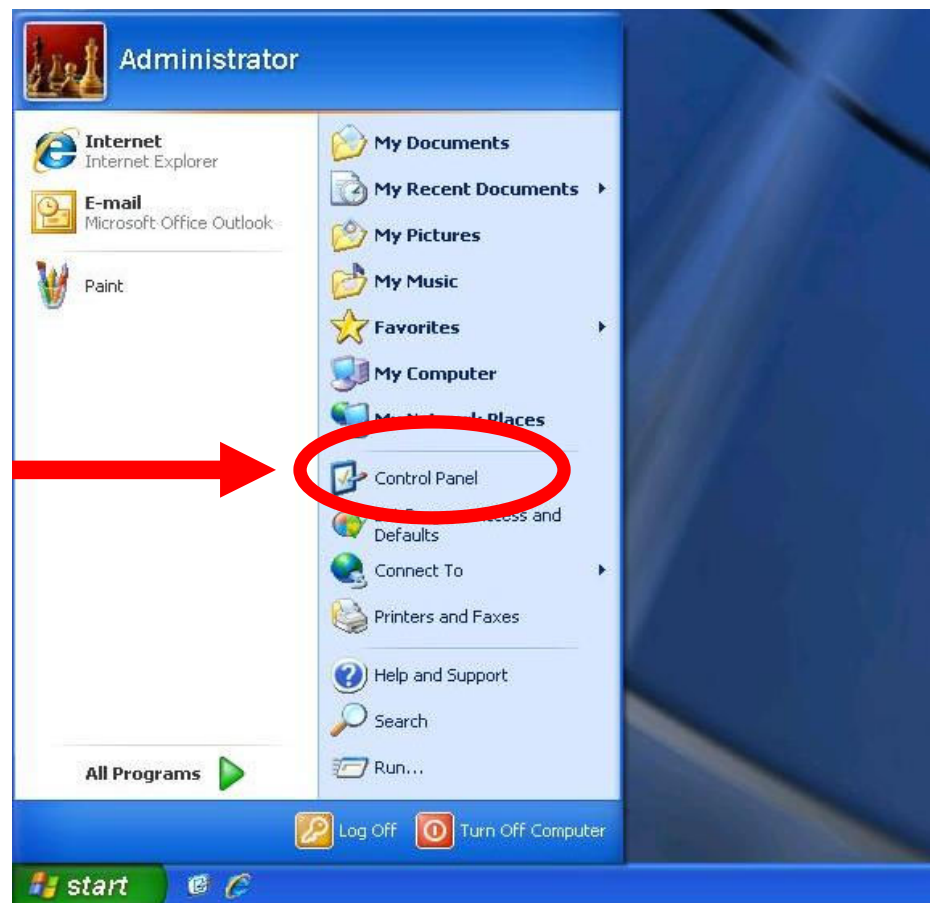


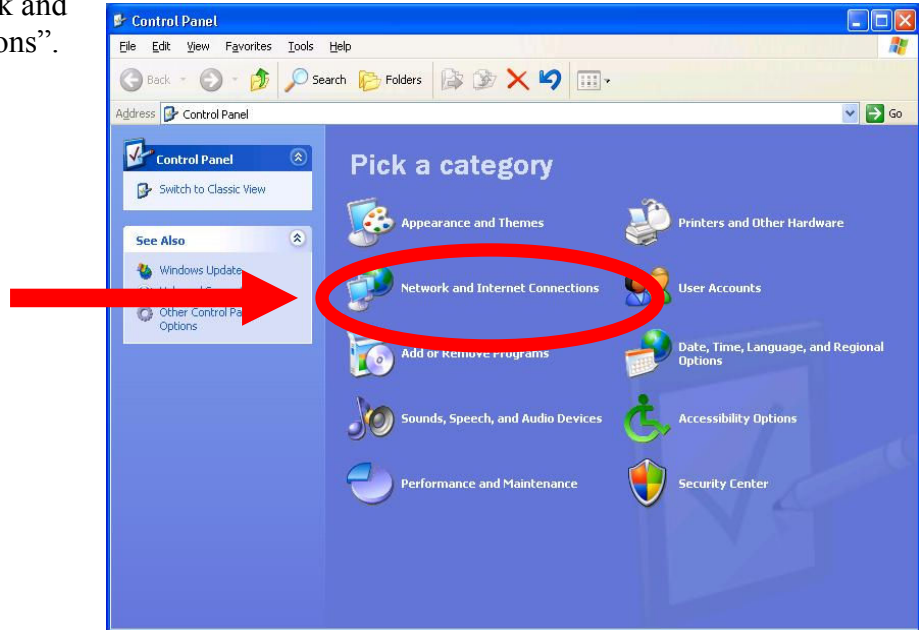
Configuring a Windows XP computer for DHCP

In order to complete the following changes you must have Administrator rights on the computer that you are using.

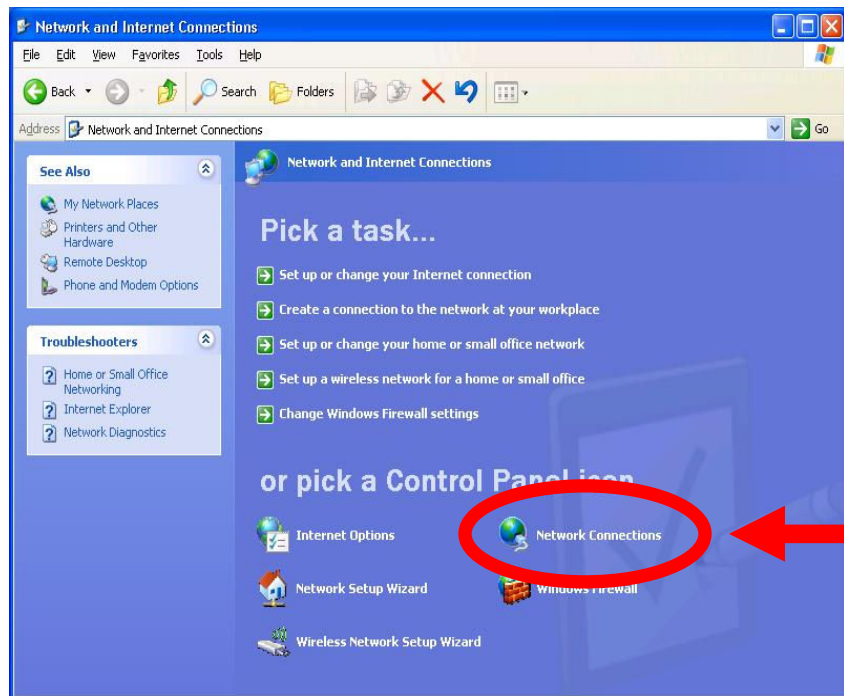
1. Click on the “Start” button and select “Control Panel”.



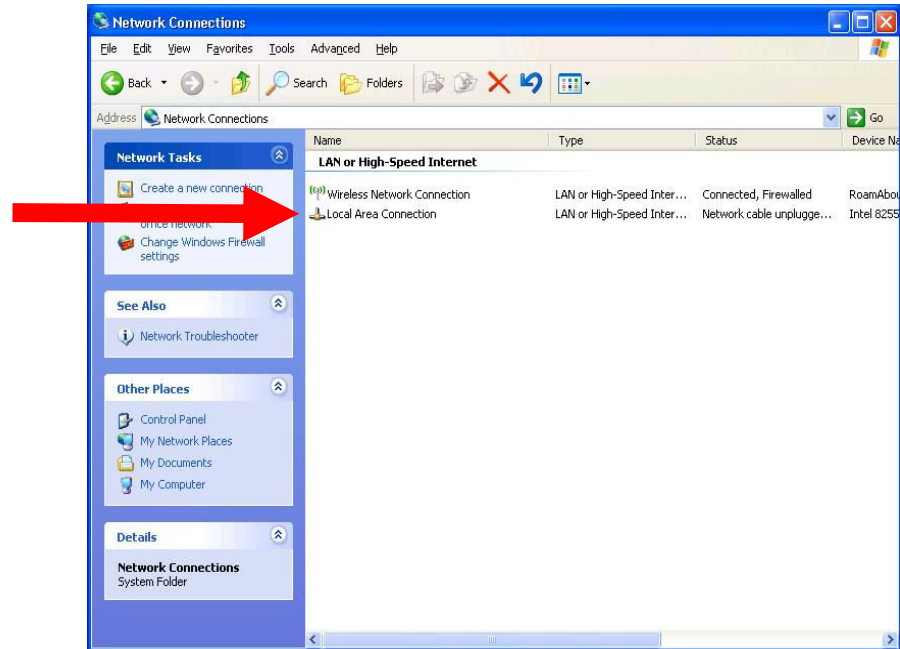
2. Click on “Network and Internet Connections”.



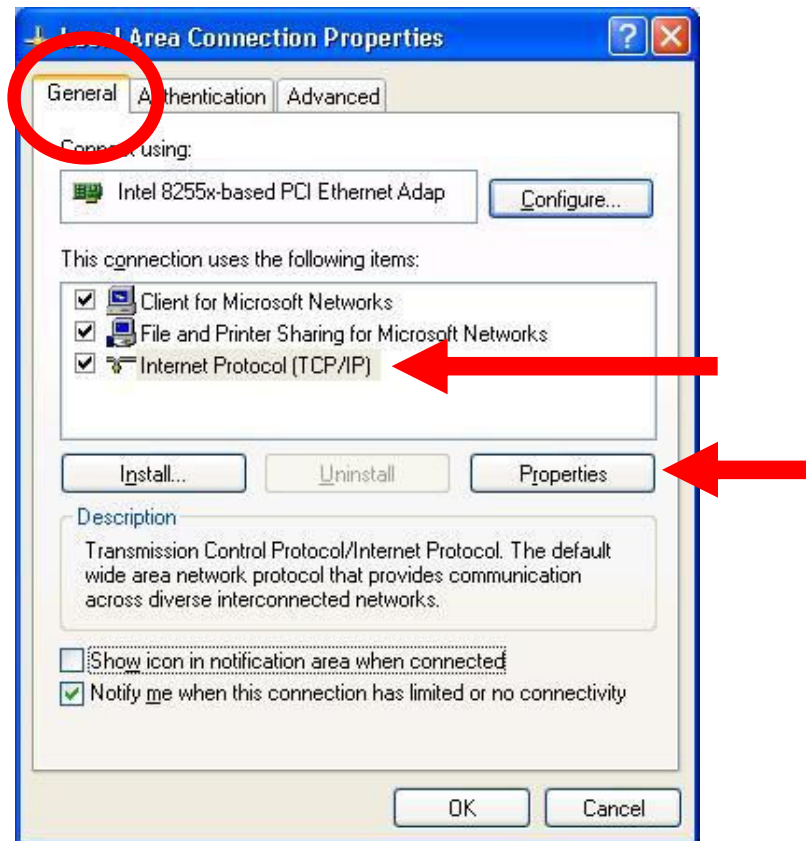
3. Click on “Network Connections”.



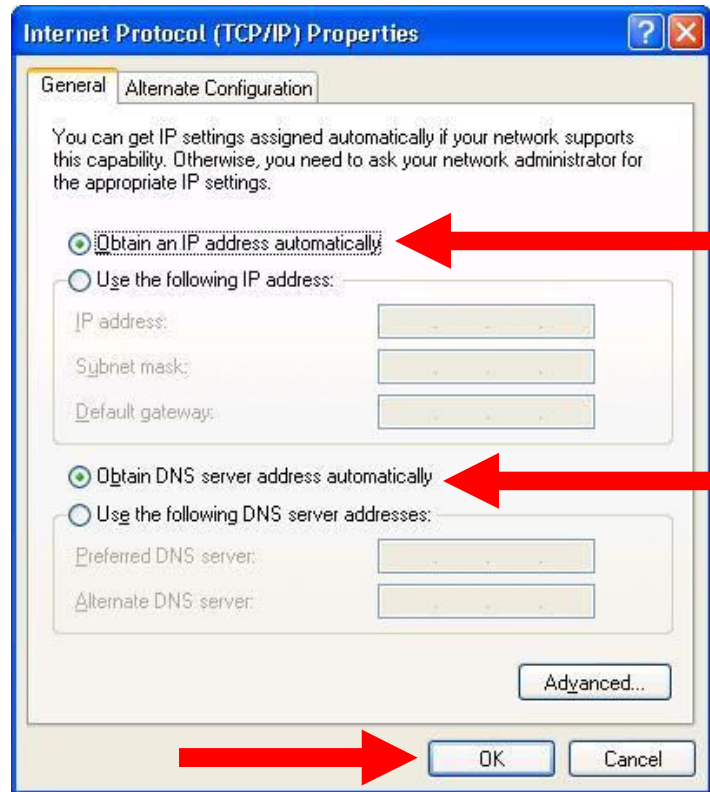
4. Double click on “Local Area Connection”.



5. On the “General” tab of the “Local Area Connection Properties” window select “Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)” and click “Properties”.



6. On the “Internet Protocol (TCP/IP) Properties” window select the options “Obtain an IP address automatically” and “Obtain DNS server address automatically” and click “OK”.



7. Click “OK” on the “Local Area Connection Properties” window to confirm the changes. And you are now configured for DHCP.
